

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-07

A RESOLUTION of the City of Bainbridge Island, Washington, accepting a Community Forest Management Plan for the purposes of implementing comprehensive management of the community forest.

WHEREAS, as required by the Washington State Growth Management Act, the City adopted a Comprehensive Plan on September 1, 1994, subsequently amended;

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan contains an Environmental Element that establishes goals and policies to preserve and enhance the community forest; and


WHEREAS, in September 2001, Resolution 2001-51, established the Community Forestry Commission tasked with development of a Community Forestry Management Plan; now, therefore,


