PROJECT REVIEW TIMELINE – 2017

February – First presentation by PAC to City Council

April-May – Public outreach meetings

- March 15th BIDA Presentation
- April 20th at City Hall
- May 24th on Washington State Ferries
- August Recommendations for 3-4 sites submitted to COBI
- Aug-Sep Feedback from Public Works and BIDA on site option; work with staff to refine budget and timeline
- September Present project to City Council at September 26th meeting for consideration and approval

CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE - 2017/2018

October-December 2017 – Design 3-4 pedestals and submit permit applications to COBI

January-February 2018 – COBI constructs pedestals

March 2018 – Installation of initial round of artwork

ARTWORK TIMELINE - 2017/2018

- October 2017 PAC develops Call for Art and identifies jurors
- November 2017 Deadline for submissions; Jury approves selections
- December 2017 Presentation of selections by PAC to City Council; artists notified of selection
- January 2018 Agreements/contracts signed with selected artists
- March 2018 Installation of initial round of artwork
- April 2018 Exhibition opening and celebrations

FUTURE TASKS – 2018/BEYOND

- Q2 2018 Review project and determine whether to request COBI funding for additional annual cycles
- Q2 2018 City Council approves funding for future cycles (TBD)
- August 2018 Issue new call for second round of artwork
- April 2019 De-Install initial round of artwork, replace with second round of selections
- Repeat annually...
