

SPORTSMAN CLUB RD AND NEW BROOKLYN RD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Bainbridge Island is soliciting detailed statements of qualifications from consultant firms with experience in street and roundabout design for improvements to the Sportsman Club and New Brooklyn intersection.

Project Description

The work to be performed by the consultant consists of preparing preliminary engineering design for improvements to the Sportsman Club and New Brooklyn intersection. The project will relieve current congestion and provide for long-term transportation network viability to ensure mobility for the town center by constructing a round-a-bout, sidewalks, and bike lanes at the intersection. Work will also include community involvement, physical survey work, permitting, and associated storm water mitigation. All work will be within 500 feet of the intersection on all four legs. The project has a mandatory 0% DBE goal.

The City of Bainbridge Island reserves the right to retain the services of the successful firm(s) for any subsequent phases (R/W, CN) associated with this project.

Requirements for Qualifications Responses

- Identify each person involved with the project team including technical partners, and briefly describe their respective roles, including:
 - a. Information regarding the team member's experience and qualifications.
 - b. Resume of key team members.
 - c. Description of how the team will be organized and led.
- Identify the project lead and their relationship to other members of the team.
- Describe the consultant's relevant project experience with similar projects. Projects described must illustrate the consultant's experience with preparing strategies and plans similar in scope to the proposed project.

Evaluation Criteria

Evaluation of RFQ responses will be based upon the following:

- Success in developing similar projects
- Quality of representative projects
- Qualifications of project team and key project managers
- References

- Request additional information on any response beyond that required by this RFQ.
- Have the final decision on the selection.

This project is scheduled for construction in 2019. Accordingly, PS&E documents, permitting, and right-of-way acquisition must be complete by December 31, 2018.
